Measure	Comment
Reading	This is a whole school focus – starting with high levels of private reading to develop a fluency in reading.
Writing	Comments from teachers during Pupil Progress suggest that basic errors are creeping into children's writing which need regular reminders, focus during editing and practice. Spelling needs attention.
Maths	This is the most significant area of need regarding catch-up. It seems that this was the area most neglected during lockdown.
